

Saliva collection and storage using the Mitra® Cartridge





















When sampling, be sure **NOT** to:




fully submerge the sampling tips


Touch the first sampling tip to the surface of the saliva. Watch it become fully saturated (~5 seconds). Then, count an additional 2 seconds and slowly remove it from the saliva. Repeat with other tip.



Close Cartridge.



Insert Cartridge into specimen bag, seal bag shut, and insert in shipping envelope.



Discard saliva and cup safely.

Do this FIRST!

Remove Cartridge from specimen bag.



Do NOT remove desiccant.



Affix any labels provided and as directed.





When affixing label to the cartridge do NOT cover vents or barcode.



Open the Mitra® cartridge by pulling apart the vented flaps.



Do NOT remove sampling tips from Cartridge.

Remove lid from provided saliva cup.
